Lot 1. Robert Hamilton, Cambus. Robert is one of the best National flyers in the country. Section winner this year from Arras and Hazebrouck. A young bird direct off a Section winner.

Lot 2. Jim Benvie, Kirkcaldy. Winner of three National races, Jim's pigeons have been winning from the Channel for many years.

Lot 3. Ian Ross, Kirkintilloch. Top-class fancier, Ian is only interested in the distance events and has the results to prove it. He has won his Section on 13 occasions. A young bird direct off this year's Section winner from Arras.

Lot 4. Peter Keogh, Broxburn. Peter is without doubt one of the country's top fanciers, winner of the 2019 Arras National and many other great results from the Channel.

Lot 5. Billy Bilsland, Ayton. Winner of six Nationals. Billy's pigeons can win from any distance but excel in the National events. In the three SNRPC National races this year he has finished 2nd, 3rd, 3rd and 5th.

Lot 6. Bob McKie, Blackhall Mill. Highly successful extreme distance racer in the National Flying Club racing into the north-east with the innovative Sportsman's Club. A 2021 young bird.

Lot 7. John Hadfield, Blackburn. Very consistent National loft, 3rd and 4th Section Hazebrouck National 2020; 2nd Open SNFC Reims; 5th Open Maidstone.

Lot 8. Danny Henderson, Dundee. A loft in tremendous form this year, winner of the Hazebrouck National. One direct from the winner.

Lot 9. S. Thomson & Son, Port Seton. One of the best in the east of Scotland with a tremendous record in National racing. Winners of four National races.

Lot 10. Bruce McKenzie, Dundee. National winning loft. Another fancier with a fantastic record in the National races. Winner of the 2020 Yearling National Arras. A young bird direct off his two National winners paired together.

Lot 11. Les McKay, Carnoustie. Les has been at the top

in National distance events for more years than he would care to remember. These pigeons excel when the going gets difficult.

Lot 12. Kevin Whitham, Dunbar. 2019 Yearling National winner, owner of Howmuir Miller, 2 x 3rd Open, 1 x 6th Open Reims, 544 miles. Young bird on offer will be a grandson off Howmuir Miller.

Lot 13. John Bosworth, Elphinstone. This National winning fancier has been at the top for many years, a past winner of Scottish Fancier of the Year.

Lot 14. D. Crowe & Son, Eyemouth. Up and coming fanciers, winners of the Billericay National this year. One direct off their National winner. Recorded very good Open positions in every National in 2020.

Lot 15. Peter Virtue, Cockburnspath. Probably the best and most consistent distance fancier in Scotland at this present time. Winner of 14 Nationals including the Reims National four times. These pigeons are much sought after as they are winning all over for other fanciers.

Lot 16. John Hadfield, Blackburn. Great National season this year, 3rd and 4th Section Hazebrouck, very consistent at the distance.

Lot 17. Billy McEwan, Dundee. Billy's birds are very hard to beat flying into Dundee in both Nationals, 1st and 3rd Section winner from SNRPC Billericay, 366 miles.

Lot 18. A. & E. Luke, Dunbar. Adam has formed a fantastic family of birds that will win out of turn at any distance. A past winner of two SNRPC Nationals.

Lot 19. Robert Hamilton, Cambus. A youngster direct off one of his Section winners.

Lot 20. Hugh Menzies, Slamannan. A 2021 young bird. Hugh has enjoyed an unbelievable season winning his Section in each of the five National races in Scotland this year.

Lot 21. Newcombe & Black, Macmerry. 2020 Arras National winners. One direct from their winner, Kardale Sonic.
