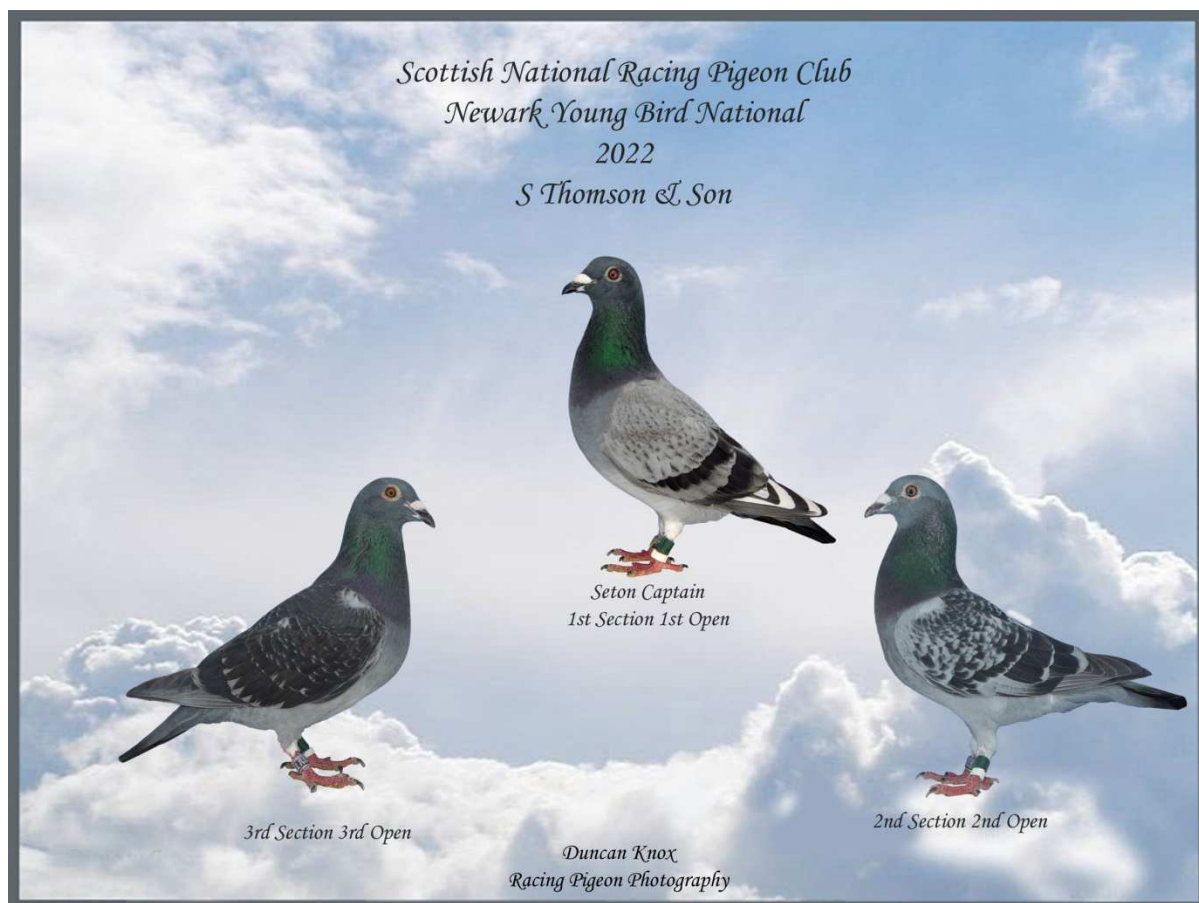
1st 2nd 3rd Open 1st 2nd 3rd Section B S Thomson & Son Port Seton



1st 2nd and 3rd Open was the partnership of Sinclair Thomson & Son of Port Seton this is the second national win for this great partnership this year having been 1st open SNFC Brighton in July this is also the second time they have won the SNRPC Young Bird national having been 1st & 2nd open in 2019 from Peterborough.

The partnership of Sinclair Thomson and son Sinclair have been winning in club fed and nationals for many years and are one of the top lofts in Scotland they have numerous great positions to their name certainly too many to mention

here and I'm sure many more to come in the future. Their record of national wins to date are; SNFC Claremont 2013, Eastbourne 2015, Maidstone 2018 Brighton 2022. And with the SNRPC Peterborough 2019 and Newark 2022.



The national winner “Seton Captain” is a Geerinckx x Soonjen cross from Taylor Brothers Newbiggin stock, breeding lines going back to their great pigeon “Alfie”

The Second open winner is a son of Van Dorp Donald when paired with a daughter of the partnership’s great pigeon Mr Consistent, Mr Consistent was a phenomenal winner

3rd Open is a dark chek cock a son of Rossi 1st open SNFC Clermont when paired with a daughter of Alfie

These birds were on darkness until 1st June then raced every week.

Worth a special mention are the members of the Traprain club who took the first 12 open positions, Eastbourne national winner John Baillie takes the 4th open spot followed closely by Tranent's Jim McNeil who had a tremendous race finishing 5th 6th 7th 8th and 9th open, James Mark takes the next two with Newcombe & Black in twelfth place.

Davy's winner is a chec pied cock of his own breeding his sire had previously scored from Arras and the dam is a prize winner from Billericay. Raced to the perch he had every race prior to the Newark national and was Davy's first bird home at the last two races.

John's 2nd section winner is red hen raced on the sliding door system (semi widowhood) She was bred by Martyn Brown of Boness and was purchased from the Central fed's breeder buyer sale on Pigeon Basics.

Jocks 3rd section winner is a chec cock bred from his Dewar Trophy winner when paired to his silver award winner, he won 1st club 3rd fed the week prior to going to the national. Jock's youngsters are raced on the darkness.

1st Section D 17th Open Tom Manger Boness



Tom had a great race finishing with 12 birds on the open result his first three being 1st 4th and 7th section. The section D winner is a chec Herman Cuester hen bred by Richard Elliot of Plymouth and is a granddaughter of Broken Foot, Lady Chester, Thunder Bolt and Mighty Super.

Aly and Jo's 2nd section winner is a lambrecht's cross his sire was bred by Callum McMillian of Allanton and the dam was bred by Maurice O'Donnell of Southern Ireland. The partnerships 3rd section winners sire and dam were bred through Lambrecht's from JPS Lofts.

Barclay enjoyed a great race winning the first three positions in section E

The 1st section winner was a young hen bred from Willie Donnachie's established Frans Zwols family inbred to the legendary Tip Top Junior. The sire of the section winner is a direct son of the Tip Top pair responsible for 53 x 1st Fed, 61 x 1st joint fed, 10 x 1st National section winners. The dam is a daughter of the Tip Top cock selected for Willie by John Gladwin and John Cowlin Formula One lofts. The second section winner his sire is a son of Den Hollander (Hermans - Bonne, Loksbergen) when paired to a granddaughter of their good breeding pair (Geerinkx) winner of 1st Glasgow fed Dunbar, 17th open Glasgow fed Kelso, 5th Glasgow fed Ripon, her sister bred for stock bred the pigeon taking 3rd section. 3rd section winner. 3rd Section 40th open is a son of Baldwin (Chris De Backer) when paired to a daughter of their good breeding pair a full sister to the dam of the 2nd section winner.

2nd section E Sire of this cock is a son of Den Hollander (Heremans Bonne,Loksbergen) when he was paired to dgt of our good breeding pair (Geerinkx) winner of 1st Glasgow Fed Dunbar, 17th Glasgow Fed Kelso and 5th Glasgow Fed Ripon 2019. Her sister ,bred for stock, bred the pigeon taking 3rd section 40 th Open.
